I, , am the plaintiff in this matter and submit this declaration based on my 1. personal knowledge of the facts and circumstances surrounding the brutal murder of my late

husband, Mark Porcelli, and the subsequent violations of my civil rights. I am the surviving spouse and next of kin to Mark Porcelli, as well as the Executor of his Estate. I bring this declaration to establish the unlawful actions of multiple defendants, including Louis Schneider, Esq., and Christopher P. Ford, Esq., and to highlight the systemic misconduct committed by the Henderson Police Department, the Clark County Coroner's Office, and the Clark County Public Administrator's Office in connection with this case.

- 2. This declaration will address the events leading up to and following Mark Porcelli's murder, including evidence of RICO conspiracy, obstruction of justice, collusion, fraud, and malicious prosecution conducted under the color of law. These events have caused severe financial, emotional, and physical harm to me and my family, and the actions of the defendants have perpetuated a deliberate pattern of harassment, intimidation, and illegal seizure of property to cover up Mark's murder.
- 3. On or about December 17, 2022, my late husband, Mark Porcelli, was brutally murdered inside our home located in Henderson, Nevada. The murder was committed using a blunt force instrument, most likely a silver claw hammer, which was discovered underneath his leg at the crime scene. The severity of the injuries inflicted upon Mark's head and the surrounding evidence point to a deliberate and violent act of homicide.
- 4. On December 20, 2022, my daughter, who was approaching her 18th birthday, returned home from college to discover her father's lifeless body. Mark was found lying face down in a three-foot pool of blood in our kitchen. His head was obscured by a lightweight wicker chair and a leather jacket draped over it, concealing the extent of his injuries. My daughter was unable to enter the house, as the doors had been locked, and she could only view her father's body through the French doors leading into the kitchen.
- 5. The trauma inflicted upon my daughter, who witnessed the aftermath of this horrific crime, has left lasting emotional scars. Upon the arrival of the Henderson Police Department at the scene, my daughter and her boyfriend's family were denied entry into the home and were prohibited from viewing Mark's body due to the severity of the mutilation.
- 6. In the 16 months preceding Mark Porcelli's murder, Louis Schneider, Esq., and Christopher P. Ford, Esq., attorneys at Ford & Friedman, engaged in a deliberate campaign of harassment, intimidation, and fraud. They initiated multiple false arrests against me,

- 7. Between August 2021 and December 2022, Schneider and Ford attempted to auction or sell my property on three separate occasions, targeting approximately \$550,000 in equity in my home. These efforts were part of a RICO conspiracy involving collusion with officers of the Henderson Police Department and the Clark County Coroner's Office. Their intent was to distribute the proceeds of my home's sale among themselves and their co-conspirators under the guise of legal authority.
- 8. Following Mark's death, the Henderson Police Department illegally searched and seized my property without a warrant. Items taken included my credit cards, checkbooks, and EU passport. These actions were conducted in violation of my Fourth Amendment rights and my rights under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. To date, the Henderson Police Department has failed to document this unlawful search and seizure.
- 9. The Clark County Coroner's Report falsely claimed that Mark Porcelli died from cardiomyopathy, citing a minor abrasion on his upper lip as the only visible injury. However, multiple photographs taken at the scene reveal a three-foot pool of blood surrounding Mark's head, as well as blood spatter and brain matter extending to the ceiling, walls, and furniture. These findings are inconsistent with a natural death and strongly suggest that Mark was murdered by blunt force trauma.
- 10. I have obtained evaluations from two independent autopsy doctors who reviewed the photographs and confirmed that the injuries and volume of blood at the scene could not be explained by cardiomyopathy. The Henderson Police Department's refusal to conduct forensic testing on the 85 visible bloodstains further obstructs the investigation and violates my right to equal protection under the law.
- 11. In response to law enforcement's inaction, I retained Aftermath Biohazard Cleaning Company to test the bloodstains. The results confirmed the presence of human biohazard material, with contamination levels measuring 717,000, nearly 200 times the acceptable limit of 4,000. Experts indicated that the high concentration suggested the presence of brain matter.

- 12. Following Mark's death, my home was unlawfully turned over to the Clark County Public Administrator's Office, despite my status as the legal owner. The Public Administrator inventoried and confiscated financial records, including old checkbooks and credit cards, as well as my EU passport. These items were seized with the intent to embezzle assets, facilitate identity theft, and obstruct my ability to leave the country.
- 13. During the unlawful seizure, officers forcibly broke into locked rooms in my home, including the master bedroom, home office, and my son's bedroom. The locks on two doors were left inoperable, further evidencing forced entry. No search warrant was provided, and no inventory of the seized items was disclosed, in direct violation of my Fourth Amendment rights.
- 14. The seizure was part of a larger scheme orchestrated by Louis Schneider and Christopher Ford, who sought to exploit fabricated bench warrants to have me arrested and prevent me from reclaiming my property. This pattern mirrors previous cases of fraudulent estate sales linked to the Clark County Public Administrator, as reported in investigative journalism by Jeff German, who was later murdered while investigating similar corruption.
- 15. As the next of kin and Executor of Mark Porcelli's Estate, I have the legal right to obtain unredacted photographs of Mark's body and access all police and coroner reports. Despite repeated requests, Lt. Mark Amundsen and the Henderson Police Department have refused to release these materials, citing the need for a court order. This refusal constitutes obstruction of justice and a violation of my First Amendment rights to petition the government for redress.
- 16. The actions of the Henderson Police Department, Clark County Coroner's Office, and Clark County Public Administrator's Office reflect a coordinated effort to conceal evidence, obstruct investigations, and intimidate witnesses to protect those involved in Mark's murder.
- 17. The facts outlined in this declaration demonstrate a pattern of systemic corruption and RICO conspiracy by the defendants, resulting in the murder of Mark Porcelli, the violation of my civil rights, and the obstruction of justice. These actions have caused irreparable harm to me and my family, and I seek accountability through the federal court system.

- 18. In the months leading up to Mark Porcelli's murder, I was subjected to a deliberate campaign of harassment orchestrated by defendants Louis Schneider and Christopher Ford, in collusion with the Henderson Police Department and Clark County District Attorney's Office. This harassment included multiple attempts to initiate false arrests against me, designed to intimidate, silence, and isolate me from legal representation and support networks.
- 19. On March 11, 2022, my late husband, Mark Porcelli, was himself wrongfully arrested on fabricated charges by the Henderson Police Department. This arrest occurred despite the lack of any credible evidence and was intended to discredit Mark and further destabilize our family. Mark was released without charges, yet the psychological and financial toll of the arrest compounded the stress that ultimately led to his vulnerability in the months prior to his murder.
- 20. I was subsequently targeted by law enforcement in August 2024, when officers from the Napa Police Department attempted to execute a false arrest warrant during my stay in California. This incident, involving Defendant Fitzgerald Walton, mirrored earlier efforts by the Henderson Police Department and highlighted the multi-jurisdictional coordination in this ongoing conspiracy.
- 21. I have credible evidence, supported by witness testimony, that Louis Schneider, a Nevada attorney, engaged in bribery to influence judicial outcomes. Specifically, in 2016, Schneider was observed delivering \$5,000 in cash to the Clark County District Attorney's Office to secure a favorable outcome for one of his criminal clients. This transaction was witnessed by Roxanne Thompson, a paralegal, who has agreed to testify regarding the incident.
- 22. The pervasive corruption demonstrated by this act extends beyond individual transactions. It is part of a larger criminal enterprise in which public officials—including District Attorney Steve Wolfson—colluded with private attorneys to manipulate court proceedings, block property sales, and obstruct justice. These actions have facilitated the systematic exploitation of estates, including mine and Mark Porcelli's.
- 23. Further investigation has uncovered evidence of money laundering activities linked to defendants Louis Schneider, Christopher Ford, and Foursight LLC. These defendants engaged in fraudulent transfers and asset concealment schemes designed to siphon funds from my property and Mark Porcelli's estate.

- 24. During the investigation into Mark Porcelli's death, critical evidence was either destroyed or tampered with by law enforcement. Bloodstains at the crime scene, which were later confirmed to contain brain matter, were neither properly preserved nor analyzed by the Henderson Police Department.
- 25. Instead, law enforcement prematurely ruled Mark's death as natural causes, effectively closing the case without further investigation. The coroner's office disposed of key biological samples before independent examiners could conduct a second autopsy, further obstructing efforts to establish the true cause of death.
- 26. Requests for forensic testing and access to the police reports and crime scene photographs have been systematically denied, depriving me of evidence critical to proving that Mark was murdered. This suppression of evidence underscores the coordinated cover-up involving multiple agencies and defendants.
- 27. The actions of the defendants have inflicted severe emotional distress and physical harm upon me and my family. The financial devastation caused by the theft of my property and legal fees has left me unable to cover necessary medical expenses.
- 28. I was diagnosed with Stage 4 cancer shortly after Mark's death, a condition exacerbated by the unrelenting stress and harassment inflicted by the defendants. My treatment has been delayed due to financial constraints, further endangering my health.
- 29. Additionally, my daughter, who discovered Mark's body, continues to suffer from post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and requires ongoing psychological care. The defendants' actions have deprived us of stability, security, and peace, forcing us to live in fear for our safety.
- 30. The quantity of blood surrounding Mark Porcelli's head and saturating his shirt is inconsistent with death by cardiomyopathy, as confirmed by two autopsy doctors who reviewed the photographs. The Coroner's Report merely noted a minor abrasion on his upper lip, which could not account for the extensive pool of dried blood, spanning nearly three feet. Additionally, the degree of decomposition observed in Mark's body is implausible, considering the ambient temperature in the home at the time of discovery was 63 degrees. These facts suggest that the Clark County Coroner was colluding with the Henderson Police Department and

the law firms of Louis Schneider, Esq., and Ford & Friedman under the color of law, violating my rights under Section 1983 and the Fourth Amendment for financial gain.

- 31. There are currently 85 drops of blood and brain matter located within a 12-foot radius of where Mark Porcelli's body was discovered. These bloodstains are present on the kitchen ceiling, a kitchen lamp hanging over the island, a door leading from the kitchen to the dining room, a French door blind leading to the backyard, and above the door frame connecting the laundry room to the living room. Henderson Police Department officers photographed these stains on September 1, 2023, and October 6, 2023, and added the documentation to the original police report regarding Mark's death. Despite this, the stains have only been referred to as "dark brown stains." The Henderson Police Department has repeatedly refused to conduct forensic testing on these bloodstains, indicating an intent to obstruct justice while endangering my life and the lives of my children, who continue to reside in the home where the murder and subsequent burglary occurred.
- 32. Due to the Henderson Police Department's refusal to perform forensic testing, I was compelled to engage Aftermath Biohazard Cleaning Company to test the bloodstains. The results confirmed the presence of human biohazard material. Specifically, the bloodstains on the kitchen ceiling measured 717,000, which is nearly 200 times the acceptable biohazard level of 4,000. Experts have indicated that the high concentration of biohazard in this area likely suggests the presence of brain matter on the kitchen ceiling. The actions of the Henderson Police Department continue to deprive me of my civil rights, in violation of Section 1983.
- 33. The results of the investigation into Mark Porcelli's murder were sent to Lt. Mark Amundsen, the Lead Homicide Detective; Chief of Police Hollie Chadwick; and Sgt. Thomas Kerouac, who was investigating the concurrent break-in that occurred during the murder. During a one-hour phone conversation on November 15, 2022, Lt. Amundsen inquired about how bloodstains ended up on the ceiling. I informed him that I believed this happened when Mark was struck on the head with a blunt force object, most likely the hammer found beneath his leg. Lt. Amundsen indicated that this would suggest a splash of blood and brain matter came from the weapon.

- 34. The police report regarding Mark Porcelli's death omits any mention of bloodstains present throughout the house, despite the existence of 23 visible bloodstains on the kitchen ceiling. Additionally, bloodstains are visible on the kitchen door, on the blind above the French Door, and above the door frame in the laundry room. The bloodstains on the ceiling are currently being tested for DNA and are likely to provide a match between Mark Porcelli and my son, Lorenzo Porcelli, as there have been no other bloody bodies found within the residence.
- 35. Following the removal of Mark Porcelli's body, an unknown number of Henderson Police officers remained at my home for several hours to conduct an illegal search without a search warrant. When I referred this information to Lt. Amundsen, he questioned how I knew that the officers stayed for several hours. I replied that they were able to locate three old credit cards, three old checkbooks, and my EU passport. These financial and identification documents had been randomly left over the years in various handbags inside my master bedroom closet and in boxes within my office closet.
- 36. My home contains 14 closets filled with clothing, handbags, and boxes of office documents accumulated over 18 years of residence and use as a home office for my business. The officers would have needed to spend several hours locating these items, including an old checkbook from my time residing in San Francisco in 1998, which was found at the bottom of a box beneath several others in my office closet.
- 37. To conduct their search, the officers forcibly broke through locked doors to the master bedroom, home office, and my son's bedroom. The doors display clear signs of having been forced open, rendering the locks inoperative on two of them. The Henderson Police Department failed to document their illegal search and seizure of my credit cards, checkbooks, and EU passport. The Clark County Public Administrator reported the seizure of these items in a detailed inventory list issued on December 21, 2022. Furthermore, since the cause of death was listed as "undecided pending toxicology," there was no legal justification for the search and seizure of my property. This unlawful action not only inflicted financial damage on my family but also violated my Eighth Amendment rights.
- 38. The Henderson Police Department's refusal to amend the police report to acknowledge the unlawful search and seizure of my property, despite being presented with

- 39. Additionally, the Henderson Police Department failed to report that they had illegally transferred my property to the Clark County Public Administrator. At the time of Mark Porcelli's death, two sets of house keys were present in the residence: one set was turned over to the Public Administrator, while the other set was unaccounted for, allowing unauthorized individuals unrestricted access to the home. During the days following Mark's death, from December 17 through December 20, and possibly beyond, while the house was under the jurisdiction of the Public Administrator's Office, my property was burglarized and vandalized, resulting in the theft of 208 items. This residence had served as the primary home for my family of four adults for 18 years.
- 40. Furthermore, the home contained property from previous residences in Italy and New York, both of which had been dismantled over the prior eight years. My son, Lorenzo Porcelli, had been home for a weekend from November 18 to November 20, 2022, and the house had remained intact during that time, with no theft or vandalism reported.
- 41. My home was illegally turned over to the Public Administrator's Office for auction, and my financial documents were seized in an attempt to deplete any assets from my credit cards and checking accounts. The EU passport was confiscated to facilitate identity theft and prevent me from leaving the country prior to my arrest on fabricated bench warrants, orchestrated by Louis Schneider and Christopher Ford.
- 42. At the time of Mark Porcelli's death, I had two fabricated bench warrants for my arrest related to unfounded domestic battery claims. These warrants had been arranged with the assistance of Louis Schneider, who had previously represented me in drafting a separation agreement, boasting that "I can get anyone I want arrested and I decide how long they are held."
- 43. The Henderson Police Department was instructed to illegally transfer my property to the Public Administrator's Office, anticipating that I would be arrested when attempting to reclaim my belongings. This reflects a longstanding pattern of illicit sales organized by the Public Administrator's Office, as reported by journalist Jeff German in an

- 44. The Clark County Coroner submitted a false report stating that Mark Porcelli had only a small contusion on his upper lip when, in reality, his head had been severely injured by the hammer. This discrepancy is the reason the Henderson Police Department refuses to release unredacted photographs of Mark's head to his next of kin. This situation constitutes evidence of RICO collusion, obstruction of justice, and fraud, which has become institutionalized within both the Henderson Police Department and the Clark County Coroner's Office.
- 45. The Henderson Police Detectives investigating the murder of Mark Porcelli, including Detective Calvano, had prepared a file in collaboration with Louis Schneider and Christopher P. Ford. This file was intended to frame me, Andreea Melissa Olteanu, for Mark Porcelli's murder. The document included a copy of a text message filed with Mark's probation officer, allegedly demonstrating the ongoing conflict between me and Mark, as well as the final page of a filing in our Family Court case. The law firms engaged in RICO collusion for malicious prosecution and fraud with the Henderson Police Department, violating my First and Fourth Amendment rights.
- 46. Starting on December 22, 2022, I had regular conversations with Detective Calvano of the Homicide Unit. During these discussions, I informed Detective Calvano that Louis Schneider, who had previously represented me, had been in constant communication with Mark Porcelli, engaging in up to 12 conversations per day during the months leading up to Mark's death. I also relayed that Schneider had boasted during our initial meeting in June 2021 that he could arrange for anyone to be arrested because his wife, Judge Lora Schneider, served as a Pro Tem Judge at the Henderson Municipal Court.
- 47. Within three weeks of our initial meeting, and after I had paid Schneider a \$6,000 retainer to draft a marital settlement agreement and represent me at a TPO hearing, Schneider had his personal private investigator, Dax Ramos, call me while I was attending an annual conference in Monte Carlo. Dax explained their strategy for handling Family Court matters in Clark County, which involved ensuring that my husband would become a felon. He further detailed plans to place a transponder on the bottom of Mark's car to track his location

when leaving bars or restaurants, with the intent of calling Henderson Police to arrest him for DUI. I expressed my disinterest in engaging in illegal activity and reiterated my refusal to incriminate my husband in any manner, conveying this to Schneider in an email. The following day, Schneider withdrew from representing me, stating that I was too demanding. Notably, on the same day that Schneider withdrew, a bench warrant was issued for my arrest on fabricated misdemeanor charges.

- 48. I informed Detective Calvano that Louis Schneider had conspired with Christopher Ford and my homeowners' association (HOA) to illegally attempt to sell my property on two occasions in November 2022, just one month prior to the ordered murder of Mark Porcelli. I urged Detective Calvano to consider Schneider and Ford as suspects in Mark's murder due to their potential financial motives, but he ridiculed the information I presented in my police report.
- 49. Beginning in February 2023, as the next of kin, I gained full access to Mark Porcelli's phone records. I discovered that he had been regularly communicating with Louis Schneider using dedicated phone lines with matching 917 numbers, which were opened on the same date. There was no legitimate legal reason for Mark to be in contact with Schneider, particularly given that Mark had filed for divorce and I had previously retained Schneider for a separation agreement.
- 50. Christopher Ford had attempted to illegally sell my property in November 2022 in contempt of a Family Court judge's order and had listed the property under his name, also in contempt of the court order. Both law firms, Schneider and Ford, intended to sell the property fraudulently before the scheduled divorce trial in March 2023, aiming to capture all equity before any potential settlement.
- 51. Schneider and Ford conspired under RICO principles, acting under the color of law with the Henderson Police Department and the Clark County Coroner, engaging in RICO legal malpractice, mail fraud, wire fraud, reckless endangerment, harassment, blackmail, grand larceny, embezzlement, obstruction of justice, and wrongful death. The Henderson Police officers were acting under directives from their chief, demonstrating institutionalized police corruption and ongoing violations of my Section 1983 rights, as well as those of my family.

52. I want to stress that both Louis Schneider and Christopher Ford have made it explicitly clear to me that they were engaged in illegal activities, boasting about their connections and the ability to manipulate outcomes in legal matters. I believe this collusion has directly contributed to the circumstances surrounding Mark Porcelli's death and the subsequent cover-up efforts that have left my family vulnerable to further harassment and criminal acts.

- 53. I have been directly affected by the actions of Defendants Louis Schneider, Christopher Ford, and others involved in a conspiracy to murder Mark Porcelli. This murder was not a random act, but a calculated maneuver by the Defendants to eliminate a key individual who could expose their fraudulent and illegal activities, including the embezzlement of property and obstruction of justice. These actions are central to the larger criminal enterprise perpetrated by the Defendants and qualify as predicate acts under the RICO statute.
- 54. I have uncovered substantial evidence directly implicating the Defendants in both the murder and the conspiracy that led to it. This evidence includes documented communications between the Defendants, both before and after the murder, which demonstrate their active involvement in planning, executing, and covering up the crime. Additionally, I have obtained records indicating fraudulent asset transfers that took place immediately following the murder, illustrating how the Defendants wrongfully seized property and funds belonging to me and my family. These deliberate actions were in furtherance of the broader fraudulent scheme that the Defendants were engaged in, causing significant financial harm to me. Beyond the financial losses, I have also endured substantial emotional distress as a result of their actions, which continue to have a lasting impact on my well-being.
- 55. Mark Porcelli was murdered under highly suspicious circumstances, yet the Henderson Police Department (HPD), under the leadership of former Chief Hollie Chadwick and homicide investigator Lieutenant Mark Amundsen, deliberately refused to conduct a proper investigation into his death. Despite clear indications of foul play, HPD dismissed the case without taking any meaningful steps to uncover the truth.
- 56. Plaintiff, Andreea Melissa Olteanu, provided substantial evidence demonstrating that Porcelli's death was not an accident or a natural occurrence but rather a criminal act. However, instead of treating this evidence with the seriousness it deserved, HPD failed to conduct a thorough inquiry. This refusal to investigate raises serious concerns about the

- 57. The refusal to properly investigate Porcelli's murder was not merely an oversight but an act of deliberate obstruction by HPD leadership. Former Chief Hollie Chadwick was fully aware of the allegations and had the authority to ensure a proper investigation was conducted. Yet, she chose to ignore the mounting evidence and failed to take corrective action, allowing the cover-up to continue under her watch.
- 58. Lieutenant Mark Amundsen, as the head of homicide investigations, bore a direct responsibility to lead an impartial and thorough inquiry. Instead of fulfilling his duty, Amundsen suppressed or ignored critical evidence that pointed to foul play. His actions—or lack thereof—deviated from standard law enforcement protocols and effectively prevented any meaningful pursuit of justice in Porcelli's case. His refusal to engage with the evidence presented to him not only obstructed the investigation but also protected those responsible for the crime.
- 59. Former Chief Hollie Chadwick eventually resigned under mounting pressure, a development that raises serious questions about her involvement in the suppression of evidence related to Porcelli's murder. A resignation under such circumstances is not merely a personnel change—it suggests deeper institutional misconduct and an effort by HPD leadership to deflect scrutiny from the case.
- 60. Chadwick's departure strongly indicates that HPD officials were aware of wrongdoing within the department and sought to remove individuals who could become liabilities as the truth began to surface. The timing of her resignation aligns with increasing public and legal pressure on the department, reinforcing the suspicion that her exit was a direct response to the exposure of the mishandling of the Porcelli investigation.
- 61. Despite being presented with compelling evidence, Lieutenant Amundsen actively refused to take necessary investigative steps. His inaction was not a matter of negligence but a clear violation of standard law enforcement procedures designed to ensure justice. By disregarding key evidence and witness testimony, Amundsen played an instrumental role in preventing a legitimate inquiry into Porcelli's death.
- 62. His refusal to conduct even the most basic investigative actions—such as reexamining forensic evidence, questioning key witnesses, or exploring potential motives—

- 63. The failure to investigate Porcelli's murder is not an isolated incident but part of a broader pattern of corruption within HPD. This pattern includes wrongful arrests, obstruction of justice, and the deliberate manipulation of official reports to protect certain individuals while targeting others unjustly. The handling of Porcelli's case reflects a systemic issue within the department—one that prioritizes covering up misconduct over pursuing truth and accountability.
- 64. Both Former Chief Chadwick and Lieutenant Amundsen held positions of power and used their authority not to seek justice, but to suppress evidence and shield those responsible. Their actions are emblematic of a department that has repeatedly engaged in misconduct, demonstrating a dangerous abuse of power that extends beyond this single case. The deliberate obstruction in Porcelli's murder investigation underscores the need for independent oversight and immediate legal intervention to expose and rectify HPD's ongoing corruption.
- have had a direct and devastating impact on Plaintiff, Andreea Melissa Olteanu. The murder of Mark Porcelli was not an isolated act of violence but a deliberate and premeditated maneuver orchestrated by the Defendants. This crime was designed to eliminate a key individual who possessed knowledge of their extensive fraudulent and illegal activities, including the embezzlement of property and obstruction of justice. The Defendants' involvement in these criminal acts forms part of a broader pattern of misconduct, constituting predicate offenses under the RICO statute. Their coordinated efforts to cover up their crimes further demonstrate the existence of a criminal enterprise aimed at financial gain through fraudulent and illicit means.
- 66. Plaintiff has uncovered substantial evidence directly linking the Defendants to both the murder of Mark Porcelli and the conspiracy that led to it. This evidence includes documented communications between the Defendants, both before and after the murder, which clearly demonstrate their active participation in planning, executing, and concealing the crime. The communications reveal discussions of the financial and legal implications of Mark Porcelli's elimination, underscoring their motives and intent.

- 67. In addition to these direct exchanges, records of fraudulent asset transfers were executed immediately following the murder. These transactions illustrate how the Defendants swiftly and unlawfully seized property and funds belonging to Plaintiff and her family, furthering their broader fraudulent scheme. The theft of these assets has caused Plaintiff significant financial harm, depriving her of rightful ownership and contributing to her ongoing legal struggles.
- 68. Beyond the severe financial losses inflicted by the Defendants, Plaintiff has endured substantial emotional distress due to their actions. The calculated nature of their conspiracy, coupled with their continued efforts to obstruct justice, has created an unrelenting cycle of harm. The Defendants' conduct has forced Plaintiff to engage in prolonged legal battles, placing an immense burden on her personal and financial well-being. The repeated interference with investigations and the manipulation of legal proceedings have prevented her from obtaining the justice and restitution she is entitled to.
- 69. The obstruction of justice committed by the Defendants has only served to compound the harm inflicted upon Plaintiff. Their efforts to manipulate the legal system, block official investigations, and suppress evidence have not only protected them from immediate accountability but have also deprived Plaintiff of any opportunity for a fair resolution. Law enforcement and judicial processes that should have provided Plaintiff with a path to justice have instead been weaponized against her, further exacerbating the suffering caused by the Defendants' actions. This ongoing criminal conduct reflects a deeply entrenched pattern of corruption that continues to endanger Plaintiff's ability to reclaim what has been unlawfully taken from her.
- 70. On December 20, 2022, my husband, Mark Porcelli, died under suspicious circumstances. This tragic event became a pivotal moment in the ongoing conspiracy orchestrated by the DEFENDANTS to defraud me, as well as the Estate of Mark Porcelli. Despite numerous indications of foul play, local authorities hastily ruled the cause of death as "Cardiomyopathy" without conducting a thorough investigation. This rushed and superficial determination, combined with the refusal to release key evidence and the active obstruction by the Henderson Police Department, strongly suggests a deliberate effort to suppress the truth surrounding Mark's death.

- 71. Following his death, the DEFENDANTS engaged in a series of unlawful acts designed to seize Mark Porcelli's assets and prevent me, as executrix of his Estate, from asserting my legal rights. These actions included:
- 72. Fraudulent Property Liens DEFENDANTS placed baseless claims against the Estate's assets, preventing their lawful distribution.
- 73. Obstruction of Justice Law enforcement agencies, working in concert with private individuals, refused to conduct a legitimate investigation into Mark's death, ensuring that those responsible would not face accountability.
- 74. Asset Seizure and Fraudulent Transactions DEFENDANTS engaged in the unauthorized transfer and misappropriation of real estate and other assets belonging to the Estate.
- 75. Continued Legal Harassment Through fabricated claims and legal maneuvers, DEFENDANTS have deliberately delayed and obstructed the administration of the Estate, inflicting financial hardship on me and Mark's rightful heirs.
- 76. These actions are not isolated incidents but rather components of a broader criminal enterprise designed to deprive me and the Estate of our rights. By covering up Mark Porcelli's murder and engaging in fraudulent legal tactics, the DEFENDANTS have caused immense financial, legal, and emotional harm to the Estate, making its inclusion in this case essential for full accountability and restitution.
- 77. My son, Lorenzo Porcelli, as the son of the late Mark Porcelli, was entitled to inherit assets and financial support from his father's Estate. However, instead of receiving the financial security rightfully owed to him, Lorenzo has been subjected to deliberate fraud, obstruction, and economic instability at the hands of the DEFENDANTS. Through unlawful maneuvers, the DEFENDANTS have misappropriated assets from the Estate, engaged in fraudulent actions to block Lorenzo's rightful claims, and imposed an undue financial burden on him. As a result, Lorenzo has not only lost the inheritance he was legally entitled to but has also faced prolonged legal battles designed to suppress justice and deprive him of financial stability.
- 78. The DEFENDANTS' actions against Lorenzo extend far beyond financial harm. Their persistent efforts to cover up the true cause of Mark Porcelli's death have inflicted severe emotional and psychological trauma. Rather than being able to grieve in peace and seek closure, Lorenzo has been forced to endure the distress of systematic obstruction of justice. He has

witnessed firsthand the DEFENDANTS' continuous efforts to suppress the truth, deny accountability, and manipulate legal proceedings to their advantage. This deliberate campaign of deception has caused long-term emotional suffering, leaving him in a state of unresolved grief and mental anguish.

- 79. Furthermore, the DEFENDANTS have actively engaged in legal harassment, prolonging litigation and employing fraudulent tactics to prevent any resolution in Lorenzo's favor. The false arrests, the economic losses, and the malicious obstruction of justice have compounded his suffering. The cumulative impact of these actions has not only deprived him of his father's legacy but has also forced him into a relentless struggle for justice, one that has been met with resistance at every turn.
- 80. Like her brother, my daughter, Sofia Porcelli, has suffered tremendous financial and emotional harm due to the DEFENDANTS' fraudulent actions and obstruction of justice. As the daughter of Mark Porcelli, she was entitled to a rightful share of his Estate, yet the DEFENDANTS have worked tirelessly to ensure that she is denied what is legally hers. Through fraudulent legal maneuvers, the DEFENDANTS have blocked her access to the Estate's assets, placed unlawful claim liens, and engaged in deliberate obstruction to prevent financial restitution. Rather than being granted the security and stability that her inheritance should have provided, Sofia has been left in a vulnerable financial position due to the DEFENDANTS' malicious interference.
- 81. Beyond financial damages, Sofia has endured immense emotional distress due to the DEFENDANTS' deliberate conspiracy to conceal the truth about her father's death. Instead of being able to mourn and process her loss, she has been subjected to an unrelenting campaign of deception, fraud, and legal obstruction. The DEFENDANTS have actively obstructed investigations, delayed legal proceedings, and engaged in misconduct to ensure that no accountability could be established. This sustained effort to suppress the truth has caused lasting psychological harm, leaving Sofia burdened with grief, frustration, and the inability to obtain closure.
- 82. Mark Porcelli's death was deliberately misclassified as "Cardiomyopathy," despite clear evidence suggesting foul play. From that moment, the DEFENDANTS initiated a concerted effort to cover up the true circumstances of his passing, ensuring that Lorenzo and

Sofia Porcelli would be denied both justice and the financial security owed to them as his rightful heirs. Instead of honoring their legal and moral obligations, the DEFENDANTS engaged in a series of fraudulent acts, each designed to obstruct, defraud, and harm the rightful heirs of Mark Porcelli's Estate.

- 83. Both Lorenzo Porcelli and Sofia Porcelli have suffered immeasurable harm due to the DEFENDANTS' fraudulent activities, obstruction of justice, and financial misconduct. As the rightful heirs to the Estate of Mark Porcelli, they have been deprived of their inheritance, subjected to deliberate legal and financial obstruction, and denied closure in their father's wrongful death. Their inclusion as parties in this case is essential to ensure they are fully compensated for their losses and that the DEFENDANTS are held accountable for their continued fraudulent and malicious actions.
- 84. Additionally, I am the rightful owner of the property located at 2438 Ping Drive, Henderson, NV 89074, which has sustained substantial damage, rendering it completely uninhabitable. The extent of the damage has created hazardous living conditions, making immediate repairs not only necessary but urgent to ensure the safety and preservation of the property. Due to the severity of the structural and environmental issues, I promptly sought financial relief through my homeowner's insurance to cover the essential restoration work required to bring the property back to a livable state.
- 85. In response to the damage, I filed an insurance claim with Markle Insurance, which, upon processing the claim, approved and disbursed funds specifically allocated for the necessary repairs. These funds were not discretionary but were earmarked exclusively for the restoration of my property, ensuring that the home could be rehabilitated and made habitable once again. The allocation of these funds was a direct acknowledgment of the legitimacy of the claim and the urgent need for repairs to be undertaken without delay.
- 86. However, rather than adhering to its fiduciary and contractual obligations, Wells Fargo Bank, N.A., which holds the mortgage on my home, has actively obstructed my access to these funds. This deliberate interference has prevented me from carrying out the critical restoration work, leaving the property in a state of severe disrepair and exacerbating the already dire circumstances. The unlawful withholding of these funds has had devastating consequences for me and my family.

87. The obstruction of justice by Defendants has only intensified the harm caused to me. Their efforts to manipulate legal processes, block investigations, and conceal their involvement in the murder and fraudulent activities have prevented me from seeking justice and recovering the assets wrongfully taken from me. The Defendants' criminal conduct is ongoing, and their efforts to protect themselves from accountability have only exacerbated my suffering. As a result of these coordinated actions, I have been deprived of my ability to pursue a fair remedy through the legal system, further compounding the harm I have already endured.

- 88. I have been the target of multiple assassination attempts, all of which were witnessed by Bijan Nikbin. On April 27, 2024, a coordinated attempt on my life took place in Henderson, involving police vehicles. On January 27, 2025, another attempt was made inside Mon Ami Gabi Restaurant at the Paris Hotel in Las Vegas. Additionally, on October 13, 2024, Bijan Nikbin himself was attacked in the parking lot of his condominium. These incidents demonstrate an ongoing conspiracy to harm or eliminate me, involving law enforcement and organized collusion.
- 89. Stewart Title Company representatives, Katie Henry and Cara Joseph, will confirm that my property was unlawfully held in escrow against my will for over five months under the direct orders of Clark County District Attorney Steve Wolfson and his entity, Foursight LLC. This obstruction prevented me from selling or managing my own property.
- 90. Nancy Archambault, a real estate agent with Simply Vegas, will testify that intimidation tactics orchestrated by Steve Wolfson pressured real estate agents and title companies to boycott the sale or rental of my home. As a direct result of this interference, I was unable to sell or rent my home for over eight months in 2023, causing me significant financial harm.
- 91. Tim Dunn, a real estate agent with Berkshire Hathaway HomeServices (BHHS), will confirm that my property was entirely blocked from being sold or even shown during two critical periods: June 2022 through September 2022 and May 2024 through September 2024. This obstruction was a deliberate effort to financially destabilize me and further the Defendants' scheme to seize my property.
- 92. George Haines, a bankruptcy attorney, will confirm that in May 2024, Foursight LLC placed an illegal lien on my property. This "special lien" was designed to force

the sale of my home rather than allow repayment, directly violating federal bankruptcy laws. Despite my Chapter 7 bankruptcy filing, which should have legally excluded this lien, it was improperly upheld due to DA Wolfson's influence over the legal system. The intent behind this fraudulent lien was twofold: first, to force an unlawful property sale to benefit Foursight LLC, and second, to either assassinate me or falsely imprison me long enough for them to execute the illegal sale.

- 93. I was on the phone with Fitzgerald Walton at the exact moment officers attempted to arrest me on fabricated charges of "using racist language in the ladies' room" at the Archer Hotel in Napa. This incident is key evidence of collusion between Napa PD, Henderson PD, Merrill Lynch, and Eric Gonzales, who worked together in a coordinated effort to obstruct justice and silence me.
- 94. At the crime scene of Mark Porcelli's murder, multiple law enforcement and first responder personnel were present and actively participated in the cover-up. Henderson Police Department officers on the scene included J. Diaz (Badge #2590), B. Eric (Badge #2782), S. Ulibarri (Badge #2737), and Sgt. Ramos (Badge #2174), who was the senior officer present. Homicide detectives M. Condratovich, A. Nelson (Badge #2126), N. Calvano (Badge #1329), and crime scene analyst J. Self (Badge #1370) were also there, along with Detective P. Farrell (Badge #1267). A total of five detectives were present, confirming that law enforcement officials knew it was a homicide but deliberately refused to investigate.
- 95. Henderson Fire Department personnel at the scene included Engine 95 and Rescue 84. The Clark County Coroner's Office representatives present were P. Chavez (Badge #309), A. Villanueva (Badge #516), and J. Gonzalez (Badge #509). Additionally, Davis Mortuary employees K. Roebuck and V. De Vera were involved.
- 96. Each of these officials had direct knowledge that Mark Porcelli was murdered, yet they actively participated in covering up the crime. Their failure to properly investigate the cause of death aligns with the broader pattern of obstruction and conspiracy orchestrated by DA Steve Wolfson, Henderson PD, and other colluding entities.
- 97. Given the systematic corruption, obstruction of justice, and failure of state and local authorities to protect my rights, I request that this Court compel the release of all

1	evidence related to Mark Porcelli's death, including unredacted photographs, police reports, and

3	98. I further request an FBI investigation into the actions of the defendants			
4	under the Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations (RICO) Act, as well as federal			
	intervention to secure my safety through witness protection until this matter is resolved.			
5	I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of Ameri			
6	that the foregoing is true and correct.
